Kattoor Fishing Village

(Mararikulam South GP - Ariyadu Block)

A Brief Profile of the Kattoor Fishing Village

Kattoor fisheries village is spread over three wards of Mararikulam South Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 16, 18 and 20. The village has a total of 1510 houses and 1547 households are living there. Among them, 45 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 43.58 percent houses are pucca, 45.03 percent are semi-pucca and 11.39 percent houses are kachha houses. About 88.94 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 90.07 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.42 %) are electrified. It is noted that 479 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 20 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 3 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one homoeo hospital. The village has one Higher Secondary School. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 10 roads of length 8.20 Km and 1.90 Km drainage. The village has 46 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 80 country fishing boats and 12 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 41 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant and one market. The village has coastal line of 2.30 Km, out of which 2.20 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
