Punnapra North Fishing Village

(Punnapra North Grama Panchayat - Ambalapuzha Block)

A Brief Profile of the Punnapura North Fishing Village

Punnapra North fisheries village is spread over two wards of Punnapra North Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 12 and 13. The village has a total of 555 houses and 620 households are living there. Among them, 70 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 19.82 percent houses are pucca, 51.35 percent are semi-pucca and 28.83 percent houses are kachha houses. About 86.49 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 86.49 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (89.19 %) are electrified. It is noted that 205 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 19 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 3 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has one High School. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 9 roads of length 4.40 Km and two culverts. The village has 19 street lights and 16 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 12 country fishing boats and 3 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 6 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has three ice plants and one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 2 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
