

Thumboli South Fishing Village

(Alapuzha Municipality)

A Brief Profile of the Thumboli South Fishing Village

Thumboli South fisheries village is spread over two wards of Alappuzha Municipality. The coastal wards of this village are 1 and 50. The village has a total of 1000 houses and 1032 households are living there. Among them, 50 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 55 percent houses are pucca, 37.50 percent are semi-pucca and 7.50 percent houses are kachha houses. About 93.50 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 91.20 percent of the existing houses. All of the houses in the village (100 %) are electrified. It is noted that 335 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 22 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 6 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub centre and one family welfare centre. The village has one LP School, one UP School and one Higher Secondary School. Ten anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 12 roads of length 7.10 Km and 4 culverts. The village has 95 street lights and 76 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 20 country fishing boats and 8 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 9 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has a protected coastal length of 0.85 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
