

Cheriyakadavu Fishing Village

(Chellanam G P - Palluruthy Block)

A Brief Profile of the Cheriyakadavui Fishing Villages

Cheriyakadavu fisheries village is spread over three wards of Chellanam Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1,2 and 3. The village has a total of 500 houses and 520 households are living there. Among them, 20 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 23 percent houses are pucca, 63.80 percent are semi-pucca and 13.20 percent houses are kachha houses. About 87 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 84.80 percent of the existing houses. All houses in the village (100 %) are electrified. It is noted that 246 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 32 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 10 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one ayurveda hospital. The village has one LP School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and five of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 1 roads of length 1.50 Km. The village has 20 street lights and only two of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 50 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 112 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 2.90 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
