

Elamkunnapuzha Fishing Village

(Elamkunnapuzha Grama Panchayat - Vypin Block)

A Brief Profile of the Elamkunnapuzha Fishing Villages

Elamkunnapuzha fisheries village is located in ward 1 of Elamkunnapuzha Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 500 houses and 579 households are living there. Among them, 83 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 20 percent houses are pucca, 58.80 percent are semi-pucca and 21.20 percent houses are kachha houses. About 76.40 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 80 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (94 %) are electrified. It is noted that 264 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 24 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 11 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has two LP schools, one UP school and one Higher Secondary School. Eight anganawadis are functioning in this village and two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 2 roads of length 3.20 Km. The village has 20 street lights and 15 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 90 country fishing boats and 5 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 89 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has six ice plants. The village has a protected coastal length of 1.50 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
