

## **Nayarambalam Fishing Village**

(Nayarambalam Grama Panchayat -Vypin Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Nayarambalam Fishing Villages***

Nayarambalam fisheries village is spread over two wards of Nayarambalam Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 11 and 15. The village has a total of 440 houses and 477 households are living there. Among them, 37 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 25 percent houses are pucca, 53.86 percent are semi-pucca and 21.14 percent houses are kachha houses. About 81.14 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 82.50 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (83.41 %) are electrified. It is noted that 196 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 32 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 7 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC and one sub-centre. The village has three LP schools, two UP schools and one High School. Three anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 6 roads of length 8.15 Km and 2 culverts. The village has 22 street lights and only ten of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 12 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 82 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one landing centre. The village has one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 3.15 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
