

Pazhangad Fishing Village

(Edavanakkadu G P Vypin Block)

A Brief Profile of the Pazhangad Fishing Villages

Pazhangad fisheries village is spread over two wards of Edavanakkadu Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 11 and 14. The village has a total of 435 houses and 485 households are living there. Among them, 50 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 37.93 percent houses are pucca, 45.98 percent are semi-pucca and 16.09 percent houses are kachha houses. About 94.48 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 84.83 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (93.56 %) are electrified. It is noted that 194 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 26 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 10 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has one LP school and one UP school. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 2 roads of length 2.40 Km. The village has 52 street lights and 48 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 82 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 62 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has a protected coastal length of 1.00 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
