

Kasaba Fishing Village

(Kasargod Municipality)

1. Brief Profile of Kasaba Fishing Village

Kasaba fisheries village is spread over 5 divisions of Kasargod Municipality. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 26, 28, 34 and 35. The village has a total of 1829 houses and 1851 households are living there. Among them, 36 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 61.51 percent houses are pucca, 35.54 percent are semi-pucca and 2.95 percent houses are kachha houses. About 66.32 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 85.73 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (96.61 %) are electrified. It is noted that 2186 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 162 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 44 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre but it is not functioning at the time of the field survey. The village has four LP Schools, four UP Schools and three Higher Secondary Schools. Sixteen anganawadis are functioning in this village and only three of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 18 roads of 20.450 km length, 5 Km drainage, 3 culverts and 3 bridges. The village has 42 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 172 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 120 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has one fish market and two ice plants. The village has an unprotected coastal line of 3.30 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
