## **Koyippady Fishing Village**

(Kumbala Gram Panchayat - Manjeswaram Block)

## 1. Brief Profile of Koyippady Fishing village

Koyippady fisheries village is spread over three wards of Kumbala Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 14, 15 and 20. The village has a total of 1009 houses and 1062 households are living there. Among them, 67 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 59.76 percent houses are pucca, 34.49 percent are semi-pucca and 5.75 percent houses are kachha houses. About 93.86 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 89.79 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (96.43 %) are electrified. It is noted that 684 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 75 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 7 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facility. The village has four LP Schools and one UP School. Five anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 11 roads of 13.140 km length, 7 culverts and 2 bridges. The village has 12 street lights and only six of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 179 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 63 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish market. The village has an unprotected coastal line of 4.670 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 7 and 8 while the financial requirements are given in Table 9.
