Poonjavikadapuram Fishing Village

(Kanhangad Municipality)

1.Brief Profile of Poonjavikadapuram fishing village

Poonjavikadapuram fisheries village is spread over three divisions of Kanhangad Municipality. The coastal wards of this village are 27, 30 and 32. The village has a total of 531 houses and 612 households are living there. Among them, 95 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 62.52 percent houses are pucca, 29.57 percent are semi-pucca and 7.91 percent houses are kachha houses. About 62.71 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 88.89 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (91.34 %) are electrified. It is noted that 430 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 79 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 13 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has three LP Schools and one Higher Secondary School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 16 roads of 22.350 km length, 0.80 Km drainage and 9 culverts. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 35 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 49 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has fully protected coastal line of 4.500 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
