Valiyaparamba Fishing Village

(Valiyaparamba G P-Neeleswaram Block)

Brief Profile of Valiyaparamba Fishing Village

This fisheries village is spread over three wards of Valiyaparamba Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 6, 7 and 11. The village has a total of 566 houses and 578 households are living there. Among them, 15 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 64.84 percent houses are pucca, 32.86 percent are semi-pucca and 2.30 percent houses are kachha houses. About 87.28 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 46.64 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.88 %) are electrified. It is noted that 175 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 36 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 6 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one homoeo hospital. The village has one LP School and one UP School. Three anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 6 roads of 10.785 km length. The village has one non functional street light. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 43 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 16 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has an unprotected coastal line of 2.50 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
