## (Kollam Corporation)

## A Brief Profile of the Kannimael Fishing Village

Kannimael fisheries village is spread over two wards of Kollam Corporation. The coastal wards of this village are 51 and 52. The village has a total of 700 houses and 709 households are living there. Among them, 11 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 88 percent houses are pucca, 9.29 percent are semi-pucca and 2.71 percent houses are kachha houses. About 83.57 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 83.14 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.86 %) are electrified. It is noted that 546 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 20 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 13 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has two sub-centres and one ayurveda hospital. The village has one LP School. Seven anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 11 roads of 15.55 Km length, 2.75 Km drainage and 5 culverts. The village has 170 street lights and 120 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 47 country fishing boats and 6 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 35 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has coastal line of 2.00 Km, out of which 1.750 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
