

Maruthoorkulangara Fishing Village Karunagappally Grama Panchayat (Karunagapally Block)

A Brief Profile of the Maruthoorkulangara Fishing Village

Maruthoorkulangara fisheries village is located at ward 18 of Karunagapilly Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 280 houses and 284 households are living there. Among them, 6 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 75.36 percent houses are pucca, 21.43 percent are semi-pucca and 3.21 percent houses are kachha houses. About 89.64 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 66.07 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.50 %) are electrified. It is noted that 142 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 14 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 7 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facility. The village has one Higher Secondary School. Two anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 3 roads of 1.550 Km length. The village has 30 street lights and 20 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 3 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 6 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has eight ice plants. The village has an unprotected coastal line of 0.50 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
