

Neendakara Fishing Village

(Neendakara Grama Panchayat - Chavara Block)

A Brief Profile of the Neendakara Fishing Village

Neendakara fisheries village is spread over three wards of Neendakara Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 8, 9 and 11. The village has a total of 950 houses and 955 households are living there. Among them, 9 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 55.89 percent houses are pucca, 42.64 percent are semi-pucca and 1.47 percent houses are kachha houses. About 96.84 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 84.42 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (96.32 %) are electrified. It is noted that 286 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 12 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 4 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one CHC, one homoeo hospital and one ayurveda hospital. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 2 roads of 0.80 Km length. The village has 70 street lights and 55 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 65 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 61 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one harbour, one fish landing centre and one guide light. The village has 17 ice plants. The village has a protected coastal line of 5.70 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and financial requirements are presented in Tables 6 and 7.
