

Pallithottam Fishing Village

(Kollam Corporation)

A Brief Profile of the Pallithottam Fishing Village

Pallithottam fisheries village is spread over three wards of Kollam Corporation. The coastal wards of this village are 39, 42 and 44. The village has a total of 1800 houses and 1805 households are living there. Among them, 8 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 90.67 percent houses are pucca, 8.33 percent are semi-pucca and 1.00 percent houses are kachha houses. About 92.50 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 91.44 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (99.39 %) are electrified. It is noted that 534 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 23 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 10 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one CHC. The village has three LP Schools and one UP School. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 5 roads of 7.25 Km length, 2.0 Km drainage and two culverts. The village has 390 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 100 country fishing boats and 100 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 72 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has one ice plant. The village has a protected coastal line of 3.50 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
