

## **Kampuram Fishing Village**

### **(Kozhikode Corporation)**

#### ***A Brief Profile of the Kampuram Fishing Village***

Kampuram fisheries village is located at half portion of ward no 52 of Kozhikode Corporation. The village has a total of 200 houses and 229 households are living there. Among them, 33 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 49.50 percent houses are pucca, 49.50 percent are semi-pucca and 1.00 percent houses are kachha houses. About 98.50 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 70 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (98.50 %) are electrified. It is noted that 93 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 7 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 3 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. Seventeen anganawadis are functioning in this village and 14 of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 3 roads of length 2.30 Km, 2.50 Km drainage and five culverts. The village has 35 street lights and 30 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 21 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 28 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant. The village has a coastal length of 1 Km, out of which 0.30 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and financial requirements are presented in Tables 77 and 78.
