

Kuriyadi Fishing Village

(Chorodu G P - Vadakara Block)

A Brief Profile of the Kuriyadi Fishing Village

Kuriyadi fisheries village is spread over two wards of Chorodu Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 16 and 17. The village has a total of 580 houses and 635 households are living there. Among them, 63 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 43.10 percent houses are pucca, 37.59 percent are semi-pucca and 19.31 percent houses are kachha houses. About 95.52 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 77.93 percent of the existing houses. More than three fourth of the houses in the village (78.45 %) are electrified. It is noted that 242 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 12 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 6 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre. The village has one LP School. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 10 roads of length 10 Km. The village has 18 street lights and 8 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 70 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 61 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has one ice plant. The village has a coastal length of 2 Km out of which 1.5 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
