

## **Melady Fishing Village** (Payyoli GP - Melady Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Melady Fishing Village***

Melady fisheries village is spread over two wards of Payyoli Gram Panchayath. The coastal wards of this village are 15 and 16. The village has a total of 452 houses and 502 households are living there. Among them, 58 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 46.90 percent houses are pucca, 32.96 percent are semi-pucca and 20.13 percent houses are kachha houses. About 82.96 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 75.22 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (87.83 %) are electrified. It is noted that 196 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 8 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 2 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has one LP School and one UP School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 7 roads of length 12.50 Km. The village has 15 street lights and 10 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 29 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 47 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish market. The village has a coastal length of 2.30 Km out of which only 0.50 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 20 and 21 while the financial requirements are given in Table 22.
