

# **Puthiyakadavu Fishing Village**

(Kozhikode Corporation)

## ***A Brief Profile of the Puthiyakadavu Fishing Village***

Puthiyakadavu fisheries village is located at half portion of ward no51 of Kozhikode Corporation. The village has a total of 400 houses and 499 households are living there. Among them, 56 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 47.50 percent houses are pucca, 50 percent are semi-pucca and 2.50 percent houses are kachha houses. About 96.25 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 75 percent of the existing houses. Three fourth of the houses in the village (75%) are electrified. It is noted that 185 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the fisheries board (Matsya Board). And 11 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 4 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007- 08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. Twelve anganawadis are functioning in this village and nine of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 3 road of length 4.25 Km, 2Km drainage. The village has 110 street lights and 70 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 45 country fishing boats are available in this fishers village. And a total of 29 kerosene permits are issue to the fisher folk in this. The village has an unprotected coastal length of 0.50 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and financial requirements are presented in Tables 81 and 82.
