

## **Thikkodi Fishing Village**

(Thikkody Gram Panchayath - Melady Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Thikkodi Fishing Village***

Thikkody fisheries village is spread over four wards of Thikkody Gram Panchayath. The coastal wards of this village are 1,2,15 and 16. The village has a total of 687 houses and 745 households are living there. Among them, 68 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 26.93 percent houses are pucca, 62.88 percent are semi-pucca and 10.19 percent houses are kachha houses. About 92.14 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 78.31 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (90.10 %) are electrified. It is noted that 276 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 12 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 4 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village. Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facility. Twelve anganawadis are functioning in this village and six of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 17 roads of length 30.50 Km and 0.45 Km drainage. The village has 36 street lights and 16 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 27 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 81 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant and one fish market. The village has a coastal length of 2 Km out of which 1 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
