

## **Valiyamangadu Fishing Village**

### **Quilandy Municipality**

#### ***A Brief Profile of the Valiyamangadu Fishing Village***

Valiyamangadu fisheries village is located in ward no 28 of Quilandy Municipality. The village has a total of 430 houses and 482 households are living there. Among them, 55 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 46.98 percent houses are pucca, 36.51 percent are semi-pucca and 16.51 percent houses are kachha houses. About 79.53 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 87.21 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (81.40 %) are electrified. It is noted that 188 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 15 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 5 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. Three anganawadis are functioning in this village and two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 7 roads of length 4.35 Km, 0.26 Km drainage and two culverts. The village has 12 street lights and only two of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 12 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 34 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has a coastal length of 2 Km out of which 1.50 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village. The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 67 and 68 while the financial requirements are given in Table 69.
