

Kadalundy Fishing Village

(Vallikkunnu Grama Panchayat - Thiroorangadi Block)

A Brief Profile of the Kadalundy Fishing Village

Kadalundy Beach fisheries village is spread over four wards of Vallikkunnu Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 20, 21 and 22. The village has a total of 655 houses and 731 households are living there. Among them, 85 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 19.09 percent houses are pucca, 52.67 percent are semi-pucca and 28.24 percent houses are kachha houses. About 81.07 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 68.40 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (93.74 %) are electrified. It is noted that 317 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 31 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 11 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC. The village has two LP schools. Eight anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in its own building. One new anganwadi is sanctioned in this village. This village has 4 roads of 8.750 km length, 1 km drainage and one culvert. The village has 24 street lights and 18 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 11 country fishing boats and 2 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 9 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has coastal line of 3.90 Km and out which 2.30 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
