

Pandakadappuram Fishing Village

(Thanoor GP-Thanoor Block)

A Brief Profile of the Pandakadappuram Fishing Villages

Pandakadappuram fisheries village is located in ward 16 of Thanur Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 400 houses and 459 households are living there. Among them, 65 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 31.25 percent houses are pucca, 43.75 percent are semi-pucca and 25 percent houses are kachha houses. About 87.50 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 95.50 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (93.75 %) are electrified. It is noted that 257 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 31 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 5 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has one Higher Secondary School. Two anganawadis are functioning in this village and one of them is functioning in its own building. One new anganwadi is sanctioned in this village. This village has 2 roads of 3 km length and 1 km drainage. The village has 80 street lights and only 10 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 30 country fishing boats and 5 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 27 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has coastal line of 1 Km and out which 0.75 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
