## Thevarakadappuram Fishing Village

(Niramaruthoor Grama Panchayat - Thanoor Block)

## A Brief Profile of the Thevarakadappuram Fishing Village

Thevarkadappuram fisheries village is spread over two wards of Niramaruthoor Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 15 and 16. The village has a total of 570 houses and 632 households are living there. Among them, 70 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 38.60 percent houses are pucca, 40.35 percent are semi-pucca and 21.05 percent houses are kachha houses. About 82.46 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 82.46 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (92.98 %) are electrified. It is noted that 297 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 32 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 10 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre. The village has one UP School. Five anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in its own building. One new anganwadi is sanctioned in this village. This village has 3 roads of 2.40 km length, 1 km drainage and one culvert. The village has 22 street lights and only 8 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 65 country fishing boats and 5 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 61 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has coastal line of 3 Km and out which 0.80 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
