

Edakkazhiyoor Fishing Village

(Kadappuram Grama Panchayat - Chavakkadu Block)

A Brief Profile of the Edakkazhiyoor Fishing Villages

Edakkazhiyoor fisheries village is spread over seven wards of Punnayoor Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 11, 14, 16, 17, 18 and 19. The village has a total of 1700 houses and 1733 households are living there. Among them, 40 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 15.88 percent houses are pucca, 71.47 percent are semi-pucca and 12.65 percent houses are kachha houses. About 92.53 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 90.59 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (91.47 %) are electrified. It is noted that 417 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 46 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 14 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has one LP School and three UP Schools. Thirteen anganawadis are functioning in this village and only four of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 28 roads of 43.15 km length, 0.60 Km drainage and 2 culverts. The village has 64 street lights and only 30 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 92 country fishing boats and 19 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 79 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one landing centre. The village has coastal line of 7.575 Km and out which 6.250 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
