## **Eriyadu Fishing Village**

(Eriyadu GP - Kodungallur Block)

## A Brief Profile of the Eriyadu Fishing Villages

Eriyadu fisheries village is spread over four wards of Eriyadu Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 20, 21 and 22. The village has a total of 766 houses and 810 households are living there. Among them, 54 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 33.29 percent houses are pucca, 50.13 percent are semi-pucca and 16.58 percent houses are kachha houses. About 93.86 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 80.94 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (91.91 %) are electrified. It is noted that 379 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 37 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 18 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one ayurveda hospital and one allopathy hospital. The village has one Higher Secondary School. Seven anganawadis are functioning in this village and only one of them is functioning in its own building. This village has 12 roads of 10.20 km length, 1.50 Km drainage and 2 culverts. The village has 41 street lights and only 31 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 63 country fishing boats and 17 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 48 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has three ice plants and one fish market. The village has coastal line of 1.875 Km and out which 1.450 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 4 and 5 while the financial requirements are given in Table 6.
