(Mathilakom Grama Panchayat -

Mathilakom Block)

A Brief Profile of the Kulimuttam Fishing Villages

Kulimuttam fisheries village is spread over three wards of Mathilakom Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1,15 and 16. The village has a total of 250 houses and 300 households are living there. Among them, 65 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 41.20 percent houses are pucca, 44 percent are semi-pucca and 14.80 percent houses are kachha houses. About 96 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 80 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (96 %) are electrified. It is noted that 129 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 12 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 9 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC. The village has one LP School. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 9 roads of 6 km length, 2.5 Km drainage and 2 culverts. The village has 100 street lights and 90 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 17 country fishing boats and 4 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 16 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish market. The village has coastal line of 1.50 Km and out which 1 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 13 and 14 while the financial requirements are given in Table 15.
