

Perinjanam Fishing Village

(Mathilakom Block)

A Brief Profile of the Perinjanam Fishing Villages

Perinjanam fisheries village is spread over two wards of Perinjanam Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1 and 14. The village has a total of 517 houses and 556 households are living there. Among them, 44 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 67.12 percent houses are pucca, 17.41 percent are semi-pucca and 15.47 percent houses are kachha houses. About 85.49 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 67.70 percent of the existing houses. Cent percent of the houses in the village are electrified. It is noted that 246 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 21 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 11 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facility. Three anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 5 roads of 4.90 km length. The village has 100 street lights and 94 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 27 country fishing boats and 7 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 19 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish market. The village has coastal line of 2.15 Km and out which 1 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
