

## **Anjuthengu Fishing Village**

### **(Anjuthengu GP - Chirayinkeezhu Block)**

#### ***Brief profile of Anjuthengu fishing village***

Anjengo fisheries village is spread over five wards of Anjengo Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 6, 7, 8, 11 and 12. The village has a total of 2030 houses and 2070 households are living there. Among them, 45 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 35.46 percent houses are pucca, 60.98 percent are semi-pucca and 3.54 percent houses are kachha houses. About 89.65 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 91.18 percent of the existing houses. More than three fourth of the houses in the village (92.31 %) are electrified. It is noted that 1026 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 52 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 15 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one community health centre. The village has one LP School, one high school and higher secondary school. Four anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 12 roads of 2.590 Km length. The village has 135 street lights and 93 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 5 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 42 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has four ice plants and a market. The village has a coastal length of 3.05 Km out of which 0.75 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 10 and 12 while the financial requirements are given in Table 13.
