## **Chilakkur Fishing Village**

Varkala Municipality

## Brief Profile of Chilakkur Fishing Village

Chilakkur fisheries village is spread over two wards of Varkala Municipality. The coastal wards of this village are 1 and 8. The village has a total of 360 houses and 386 households are living there. Among them, 39 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 55.55 percent houses are pucca, 30.55 percent are semi-pucca and 13.88 percent houses are kachha houses. About 73.61 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 84.44 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (93.33 %) are electrified. It is noted that 165 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 22 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 10 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one allopathy hospital. The village has two LP Schools and a high school. Seven anganawadis are functioning in this village and six of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 10 roads of length 16 Km. The village has 110 street lights and 80 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 28 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 96 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant. The village has a protected coastal length of 0.40 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village
