

## South Kollengodu Fishing Village

(Kulathoor Gram Panchayat - Parassala Block)

### *Brief Profile of South Kollengodu fishing village*

South Kollengodu fisheries village is spread over three wards of Kulathoor Gram Panchayath. The coastal wards of this village are 8, 9 and 10. The village has a total of 1875 houses and 1914 households are living there. Among them, 45 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 4.64 percent houses are pucca, 92.11 percent are semi-pucca and 3.25 percent houses are kachha houses. About 91.47 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 92.96 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (98.93 %) are electrified. It is noted that 928 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 32 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 12 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub centre. Five anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in rented building. This village has a network of 16 roads of length 8.957 Km, 2.207 Km drainage and three culverts. The village has 95 street lights and 40 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 76 country fishing boats and 12 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 92 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has a coastal length of 5.10 Km, out of which 4.50 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
