

Thazhampally Fishing Village

(Chirayinkezhu GP - Chirayinkeezhu Block)

Brief profile of Thazhampally Fishing Village

Thazhampally fisheries village is spread over three wards of Chirayinkeezhu Gram Panchayath. The coastal wards of this village are 13, 14 and 16. The village has a total of 982 houses and 1002 households are living there. Among them, 27 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 45.82 percent houses are pucca, 48.26 percent are semi-pucca and 5.90 percent houses are kachha houses. About 89.91 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 86.15 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (90.32 %) are electrified. It is noted that 486 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 31 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 13 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village one ayurveda hospital is functioning. The Village has Three LP schoola, Two UP schools and One higher Secondary School Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 12 roads of length 13.47 Km. The village has 60 street lights and 31 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 165 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 116 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one harbour two ice plant and one fish market. The village has a coastal length of 4 Km out of which 3 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
