Vettoor Fishing Village

(Vettoor Gram Panchayat - Varkala Block)

Brief Profile of Vettoor Fishing village

Vettoor fisheries village is spread over four wards of Vettoor Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 11, 12 and 13. The village has a total of 1100 houses and 1158 households are living there. Among them, 70 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 58.54 percent houses are pucca, 30.90 percent are semi-pucca and 10.54 percent houses are kachha houses. About 86.36 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 87.09 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (72.27 %) are electrified. It is noted that 279 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 11 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 3 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has no hospital facilities. The village has onehigh school School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 21 roads of 21.25 Km length. The village has 70 street lights and 70 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 65 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 8 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant and a market. The village has a protected coastal length of 0.10 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
