separately for each market. As specified for the assignment, the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), shall also remitted as Demand Draft in the name of Managing Director, KSCADC.

The bids can be submitted up to 6.03.2023 at 5.00 PM. The technical bids will be opened on 9.03.2023 and date of opening of financial bid will be on 12.03.2023.

Thebids will be opened at Office of Kerala State Coastal Area Development Corporation Limited, First floor, ChalachithraKalabhavan building, Vazhuthacaud, Trivandrum- 14 in thepresence of the tenderers or their representatives who wish to be present. The Financial bid ofbidders who fulfill the conditions in the technical bid shall only be opened.

The bidders will have to deposit an amount of Rs. 5000/- at the time of submission of the bid as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD). KSCADC is not liable to pay any interest on the EMD. The Earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded without any interest soonafter the execution of an agreement by the successful tenderer, or after the expiry of the validityperiod of the tender. The successful tenderer to whom the contract is awarded will have to depositas initial security deposit, a further amount to make up 5 % of the value of the accepted tenderincluding the Earnest Money. The said amount will be kept as Performance Guarantee and theamount without any interest shall be refunded after successful completion of the assignment. KSCADC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders in part or full without assigningany reason thereof. The security deposit will have to be made within 14 days from the date ofacceptance of tender (work order), failing which KSCADC at its discretion may revoke the letterof acceptance and forfeit the earnest money deposit furnished along with the tender.

1. INTRODUCTION

Modernization of domestic fish markets plays a crucial role in the development of the fisheries sector of the State. Apart from ensuring nutritional and food security, it also helps in minimizing the post-harvest losses, increase revenue; enhance employment opportunities and offers high standards of hygiene and sanitation leading to food safety. The importance of domestic marketing can be understood from the fact that only about 15% of the total fish landing is utilized for export of fishery products and the remaining 85% is distributed through domestic markets. As more and more trade restrictions are being imposed on the fishery product exports, a well-developed domestic marketing system only can ensure the viability of the fisheries sector.

Major share of the fish caught is marketed fresh and the remaining is utilized in the form of processed, dried, smoked and reduced to fish meal. However the harvested fish is not evenly distributed to interior areas due to lack of proper transportation and non-availability of proper storage facilities. Therefore there is a need for balanced system of distribution to make fish available in the interior areas at reasonable prices.

The State Government had declared a package of Rs. 2000 Crore for the inclusive development of the coastal area in budget speech 2018. Renovation of fish markets of the State is one of the components mentioned in the above package. In tune with the declaration, Department of Fisheries through Kerala State Coastal Area Development Corporation Limited had identified various fish markets existing throughout the State which requires an immediate facelift.

In the backdrop of the above, KSCADC intends to invite applications/ bids from interested and reputed firms for Preparation of a Self Contained Detailed Project Report for "State of the Art Wholesale Fish Market at Aluva in Ernakulam district and in Kozhikkode district" in Kerala so as to enable the funding of the state as well as Government of India. It should contain Project information, location details, technical feasibility through structural and architectural plan, design aspects, detailed estimate in PRICE software, financial feasibility through cost benefit analysis, information on statutory clearances, project outcome, study results and preparation of BOQ & tender

- 4.4. The cost of the project shall exclude the cost of land, statutory payments to other departments and departmental overheads, taxes and duties.

5. MODE OF PAYMENT

6. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 6.1. The applicants shall provide State of the art creative designs keeping in view the aesthetics and utilitarian aspects of the structures capable of being constructed at an optimum cost.
- 6.2. The services under any stage will be treated as complete only after such services carried out by the applicants are approved by KSCADC.
- 6.3. In the event of the applicant's firm closing its business or failing to complete balance work within reasonable time, KSCADC shall employ other agency to complete the work at the cost of the original applicant.
- 6.4. In the event of the failure on the part of applicants to complete their work, committing a breach of any one or more of the terms and conditions of the agreement, the Authority will be entitled to rescind this agreement without prejudice to its rights to claim damages or remedies under the law.
- 6.5. The applicants shall be solely responsible for the competency and the correctness of the detailed design of the infrastructure and shall be fully responsible for the plans, estimates, designs, drawings and specification provided by them for items described in the schedule or work (BOQ). The drawings, designs etc., shall conform to the statutory provisions and standards laid down by the Bureau of Indian Standards or where no such standards exist, to the standards laid down by any similar body and they shall also be efficient, economical and sound in every manner.
 - 6.6. The applicants must have the approval of KSCADC before initiating any stage of its duties.
 - 6.7. The applicants shall supply to KSCADC free of cost five sets of Reports, DPRs, all drawings, specifications, estimates, etc., prepared for all stages along with one set of drawings on reproducible tracings. Any additional sets required by the Department will be paid for on actual cost basis.

- 6.8. The applicants shall make necessary revisions in the drawings and other documents submitted by them as may be required by KSCADC.
- 6.9. The designs, drawings, specifications and documents prepared for the project will be the property of KSCADC. The applicants shall not use these documents for any purpose without approval from the KSCADC.
- 6.10. The KSCADC will have liberty to postpone or not execute any work and the applicant shall not be entitled to any compensation or damage for suchpostponement or non-execution of the work except the fees which are payableto the applicant up to the stage of services then in progress.
- 6.11. The applicant shall provide extra services, if any, essential for the successful implementation of the scheme. These shall comprise of works that are not included or covered under this agreement. However, any or all services that are in contravention of the standards, norms or requirements provided by the Department, local Municipal bye-laws, etc., shall be to the account of applicants, and redoing of all such works services shall not come in the purview of extra work.
- 6.12. If at a later date it is found that the consultant has furnished false information in respect of qualification information furnished by them, the bid / Agreement will be summarily rejected and no further payment will be made. Further the EMD submitted by the Consultant shall be forfeited.
- 6.13. Any dispute arising out of the provision of this agreement shall be subject to the jurisdictions of the courts at Thiruvananthapuram only and no other courts shall have jurisdiction to entertain any petition, application or suit to resolve such disputes.

8.1. Format And Signing Of Bid

The Technical Bids and Financial Bids of each market separately are to be submitted to KSCADC as perthe guidelines specified thereon. Also Bid (Financial) shall be in the format annexed to this EOI must be submitted. The Financial bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and signed by the authorized signatory of the Bidder who shall also sign all the pages of EOI. In the Financial proposal, the bidders are required to quote their fee (As lump sum) for complete services to be rendered for each market to KSCADC in preparation of DPR the State of the art wholesale Fish Market at Aluva in Ernakulam district and in Kozhikkode district.

The fee quoted by the bidder shall be exclusive of GST and other statutory deductions, but inclusive of all other taxes overheads, travel expenses, incidentals, cost of site visits, liaising with the office of competent authority, printing cost of documents, Reports etc.
